I am writing to let you know that the Cooper Square Committee will be holding our Annual Dinner Gala on Thursday, October 16th at Village Park Banquet and Catering Hall at 155 Avenue A (East 10th Street) in the East Village/Lower East Side. Please mark the date on your calendar. I would like to ask that your company consider being a sponsor of the event, or place an ad in our program book. We will be celebrating our 55th Anniversary! The theme of the Gala will be "All Under One Roof: Celebrating Innovative Housing Models". We will be honoring Community Access, the Cube Building, and the Cooper Square Community Land Trust.

Today, our programs and services include the following:

- Counseling over 600 tenants per year facing housing issues, from evictions to harassment to lack of repairs. We started a leadership training workshop series, and are leading a city-wide campaign to reform the NYC Dept. of Buildings' enforcement to ensure tenants' safety during major renovations of occupied buildings.
- ♦ We help low income people, including many seniors, to access entitlements such as Medicaid and SNAP. Our new Senior Program is helping seniors age in place by linking them to support networks, home health aides, Meals on Wheels, recreational opportunities, and providing workshops on nutrition, medication safety, falls prevention, and much more.
- We launched an HDFC Greening Project a few years ago, and have leveraged over \$1 million in weatherization funds to 17 buildings. Buildings have received new boilers, new windows, and installation of new water saving fixtures and fluorescent light bulbs.
- ♦ We are in the process of turning a vacant city owned building on East 13th St. into housing for up to 18 homeless LGBT youth. Renovation begins in September.

We rely on support from public and private sources, including local residents and business owners. Our staff of 8 people, and our many volunteers deliver cost effective programs to the community.
